How will students recognize the elements of design in their own art work and in the world around them?</p> <p><b>COLOR</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Review the color wheel</li> <li>*Primary color</li> <li>*Secondary color</li> <li>*Warm/cool colors</li> <li>*Complementary colors/neutral colors</li> <li>*Monochromatic colors (mixing paint to make different values)</li> <li>*Tertiary colors</li> <li>*Tints/shades</li> </ul> <p><b>LINE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Using a variety of line students will create art projects</li> <li>*Students will recognize how variation of line creates different effects</li> </ul> <p><b>SHAPE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Students will identify shapes in the world around them and apply to their artwork.</li> </ul> <p><b>TEXTURE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Students will use texture on a 2-D and 3-D surface</li> </ul> <p><b>SPACE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Students will recognize the difference between foreground, middle ground and background.</li> </ul>	<p>All of the seven elements of art will be reintroduced to the fourth graders in a variety of art projects.</p>
